Why we must endure

Hebrews 12:18-24 ESV

Their alternative to enduring

- First, an alternative devoid of relationship
 - o For you have not come to what may be touched
 - Hebrews 4:16 ESV, Hebrews 11:6 ESV
- Second, a description of the alternative
 - a blazing fire and darkness and gloom and a tempest and the sound of a trumpet and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that no further messages be spoken to them
 - Deuteronomy 4:9-12 ESV
- The results of their alternative: Fear
 - o Indeed, so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I tremble with fear."
 - Deuteronomy 9:19 ESV
- This was what they could turn back to!
 - A situation of fear due to the judgment of their own sin. And because of their fear and sin: separation from God

Two alternatives to enduring "the race set before us"

Not Judaism but legalism:

 Legalism is behavior motivated by the false notion that sinners can earn favor with God, either before or after salvation, through legal means—obedience, ritual, selfdenial, or whatever.

Not Judaism but functional atheism:

 Functional atheism is me disregarding God's plan of reconciliation for a selfdetermined way

God's means of salvation is displaced by us seeking to save ourselves

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Our reason for enduring

But you have come

- You have come to = you get God!
 - o Hebrews 4:16 ESV, Hebrews 11:6 ESV

7 descriptions of getting God

- 1. to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem,
 - Hebrews 13:14 ESV
- 2. and to innumerable angels in festal gathering,
 - panegyris a joyful gathering in order to celebrate a festival
- 3. and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven,
 - the whole communion of saints
- 4. and to God, the judge of all,
 - relationship
- 5. and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect,
 - faithful men and women under both covenants who have died
- 6. and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant,
 - Jeremiah 31:31-34 ESV, Hebrews 9:15 ESV
- 7. and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.
 - Means of mediation sprinkled blood death on a cross
