"with truth"?

- 1. "Standing firm against the devil's schemes" requires truth
 - a) Truth = the facts about God and about life

Becoming a Christian ...Romans 6:17,18 and Romans 10:13 Experiencing freedom...John 8:31,32 Being led astray... II Corinthians 11:3

b) Truth = a sincere commitment to the facts

Both are essential. HOW DO YOU GET CONVINCED?

_→ It's a gift: God gives faith ~ Romans 10:17

APPLICATION

a) Accept the Bible as the truth
