#28. Armoured With Faith, Part I

Ephesians 6:16

... in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.

REVIEW:

- ➤ Walking worthy/in love/in the light/wisely
- Standing firm against the devil: his deceitful schemes

TODAY (and next Sunday) : "the shield of faith"

1. The problem: a barrage of "flaming arrows"?

2. The problem: Especially deadly attacks? <u>Temptations</u> to <u>actually disobey</u> God

gossip / malice / stealing / dishonour your parent(s) / indulge sinful sexual e.g. desire

Still involve lies, accusations... Still attempts to deceive us.... But here the devil is not attacking our view of ourselves or our view of our salvation or our view of God, but rather he is actually tempting us to sin: to disobey God... doing what we ought not do - or failing to do what we ought. Sins of commission and sins of omission.

"Flaming arrows" = temptations to destructive behaviour: Why God hates sin and so should we.

3. The protection: a shield

4. The protection: faith

<u>Def'n</u>: The desire and ability to trust and obey God

What we've got to protect ourselves? A shield: just the thing. Thyreon, from the word "door" Two layers of wood glued together, covered in hide and bound with iron.

Faith: the God-given desire and ability to trust and obey God:

Taking up the shield means seeing the flaming arrow in the bow and the bow being bent – and deliberating choosing to obey God!

1. Be <u>clear on the obedience</u> you are called to
